At WFP Centre of Excellence, we are looking for talented students or recent graduates to support us as a Translator Voluntary Assistant in Brasilia, Brazil. You will be involved in the translation of social protection and school feeding technical documents <u>from Portuguese</u> to French and from French to Portuguese and will give support to all translation related tasks to the programme unit's work. The opportunity will be for part-time voluntary work at the Brasília office, with possibility of flexible hours to be agreed between the volunteer and the programme unit.

Responsibilities and tasks

As a Translator Voluntary Assistant, you will be working with the Programme Unit team, under the supervision of the the Programme Officer. You will be expected to get knowledge



and experience working with the activities related to translation, and will be responsible for:

- Translating technical documents from Portuguese to French and from French to Portuguese;
- Keeping an updated status of all your tasks and report on translation processes progress;
- Assisting in the compilation of the organization's glossary of terms;
- Performing other related duties as required.

Standard minimum qualifications

Education: You must be enrolled in the final semesters of a graduate or post-graduate programme from a recognized university in the area of Languages, Translation. Fresh graduates are also encouraged to apply.

Skills: Ability to work with a deadline, good communication skills, good time management.

Languages: Fluency in spoken and written Portuguese and French.

Desired experience

Previous working experience with translation of technical documents will be an asset, but not mandatory.

Definition and principles

WFP volunteers are individuals who donate their services to the Programme. They have no relationship to the United Nations Volunteers Programme (UNV), nor to the WFP Intern Programme. The objective of this opportunity is the exchange of experiences between the volunteer and the Centre during a short time work that will contribute to the design of an online knowledge platform on school feeding and food security.

There is no compensation for such volunteer services, however the Programme provides:

- Insurance under the MCS scheme for service-incurred accident/illness/death;
- Coverage under the WFP war risks/malicious acts policy;
- Certificate of completion of work, including workload and performed activites.

The Centre of Excellence will also include the name and contact of volunteer in the final documents translated and provide a certificate based on the support provided.



How to apply?

Step 2 - Click on - <u>Translator Voluntary Assistant French</u> - Apply to submit your application.
NOTE: You must complete Step 1 and 2 for your application to be considered.

In the application form, ensure filling the mandatory sections, attaching your CV, answering the pre-screening questions and agreeing on the legal statement before submitting your application.

Selection of volunteers is made on a competitive basis on account of potential and performance. All applicants will undergo a process which includes screening against job requirements, a technical test, and a panel interview.

Candidates must be Brazilian nationals or must have permission to work in the country.

We look for applicants with the highest integrity and professionalism who share our humanitarian values. We commit to promote diversity, gender parity and equality between men and women.
